

Cumberland River camping trip:

Come join us on the Cumberland on October the 15th and 16th. As you all know the Cumberland is the pre-eminent cold water fishery in Kentucky. You can expect to catch Browns, Rainbows and now Brook Trout during this trip. Typically the River is low and wadeable this time of the year although this isn't guaranteed. If the level of the river does not allow for safe wading several of us will have boats and will gladly share space on them, There will also be several Hobie sit-on top kayaks available for our use , courtesy of J&H Outfitters. These kayaks are all outfitted with the revolutionary "Mirage Drive Systems" which leaves your hands free to fish, this will be a great way to experience the River.

You can join us on Friday night or if your schedule does not allow that, come down on Saturday morning. Friday night dinner will be on your own and Saturday night will be a pot-luck dinner which historically have been very tasty. This trip is a great opportunity to make fly-fishing friends in a friendly and fun environment, catch some fish and enjoy the great outdoors. If you are a beginning angler or unfamiliar with the Cumberland I would encourage you to come, since there will be plenty of people happy to show you how to fish the river successfully. The Chapter will cover the cost of the camp-sites at Wolf-Creek dam campground and firewood. Because of campground reservation requirements, please make sure to RSVP me no later than Oct 8th.
